## EFFECTIVE METHODS OF TEACHING ENGLISH TO TEENAGE LEARNERS

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**Abstract:** This article talks about increasing the effectiveness of modern methods of learning English, which are in demand today, solving the problems of teenagers in language learning, and the correct use of English songs in the course of the lesson. According to him, the importance of English songs in the formation of listening skills is explained in detail. If the selected song develops listening skills, it is explained that the use of its text in the lesson also affects the development of speaking skills. on themselves regularly, using a variety of new methods, techniques and technologies to teach students quickly and effectively.

The use of songs is especially important in the use of new materials in teaching English, especially in the development of listening skills. There are many benefits to teaching young learners using songs.

Songs are one of the most magical and culturally rich resources that can be easily used in language classes. The songs suggest a change from the usual classroom activities. They are valuable resources for developing students 'listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Songs can also be used to teach a variety of language elements such as sentences, vocabulary, pronunciation, rhythm, adjectives, and affixes. Learning English through songs also provides a non-hazardous environment for students who are generally tense when speaking English in class.

Songs can also be used for the presentation or practice phase of grammar lessons. They can encourage broad and intense listening and inspire creativity and imagination in a relaxed classroom environment. When choosing a song, the teacher should take into account the age, interests and language of the students in the song. To reproduce it is also helpful to allow students to participate in the selection of songs.

We should also add that the song creates a positive mood in the audience. Helps to improve mood, improve mental performance, physical freshness. The use of songs in the classroom ensures that the lesson is interesting and colorful. Increases interest in the lesson in students. Accelerates the learning process. Helps to improve language skills.

It should also be noted that learning a profession or a subject is always a challenge for teenage students. Especially learning foreign languages is their most painful point. The teacher should approach these situations with special attention. When teaching English to teenagers, teachers need to be more careful and keep a few things in mind.

Make instructions clear and easy to understand - When giving instructions to a new group of students, remember to keep it simple and short, without being too formal or polite. If the teacher wants to be polite, he can add simple words such as "Please" and "Thank you" to his speech, because at the elementary level, students know only a few words in English and are very formal. there will be many in the language.

Encourage teenagers to listen and then speak - The teacher should listen to pronunciations, pay attention to grammar and encourage students to develop their vocabulary before they start speaking English. However, you will find that many students try to speak the language as soon as classes begin. But few expect the process to go smoothly. The teacher should plan his lessons wisely so that the teenage students can speak English well enough and communicate soon.

Reinforcement and Repetition - Students need lots of repetition and reinforcement to learn sentences carefully. This may sound problematic, but it is an effective way of learning. That is, saying a sentence, breaking it down, going back and forth, and repeating it until the new learner understands and learns it.

Avoid scientific language - Terminology should not be used as many students do not know how to use it when communicating. For example, irregular verbs, students are not sure if one or the other is used. Therefore, it is better to use visual symbols for better understanding. Try to find out how much they understand by asking relevant questions or asking for further clarification. "Do you understand?" it is permissible not to ask questions. When students are asked this question, they may be reluctant to answer correctly or even believe that they have understood everything.

Remembering that students know their own language - When students speak broken English, it is important to remember that they are trying to think in their own language and translate it into English when they speak. Show them that, try to teach them to keep the flow and rhythm and be patient.

Do homework correctly - When starting a new lesson, prepare well for the topic and prepare a lot of related activities. It is necessary to clearly plan how to explain the topic, properly organize the lesson and give the correct guidance to the students.

English teachers should think deeply about the various problems that may arise in the process of language teaching and look for their solutions. They should focus on making the lesson interesting and understandable.

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
