

SHRINE SIGHTS OF OUR COUNTRY

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As we all know, our country has a very long history. We can learn this from many sources. As one example, we can cite the Registan square located in the city of Samarkand.

According to another legend, the water has a wonderful taste. The well of Hayvak was dug by Shem, the son of biblical Noah.

When it comes to Surkhandarya, many describe it as the land of wrestlers. The oasis of Surkhan is not only the land of wrestlers, but also the land of great scientists who made a worthy contribution to the civilization of science. We have more or less information about the tomb of Al-Hakim at Termizi located in this area. For example, this shrine was built on the banks of Amudarya. When you enter the complex, you will be delighted by the beautiful flowers on both sides, basils spreading around, and various trees. Just to the right of the entrance there is a souvenir shop for tourists. The entrance to the Al-Hakim at Termizi mausoleum consists of a large hall, and the ornate ceiling under the dome will delight anyone. The decorations here reflect the style of Surkhan. The next big room is adjacent to the tomb of Al-Hakim at Termizi, there are guests who enter here, they certainly pray for the right of Al-Hakim at Termizi, and what is interesting is that the decorations are written in the verses of the Qur'an. In short, it has become a dream destination for every tourist.
