Representatives of foreign pedagogy E. Segin, J. Demor, O. Dekroli, as well as local scientists L. S. Vygotsky, A. I. Graborov, E. A. Ekjanova, T. S. Komarova and others emphasized the important role of art in correctional works.

Children's artistic activity ensures their emotional development, forms the motivational-need side of their production activity, helps to develop perception, voluntary attention, imagination, speech, fine motor skills, hands and communication. Perception of works of art creates pleasant impressions and helps to transform Sh into positive emotions. The images of artistic creation reflect all kinds of unconscious processes, including fears, internal conflicts, childhood memories.

A special place is given to the product of artistic activity in artistic pedagogy. Children's drawings are considered, first of all, as a projection of the child's personality, a symbolic expression of his attitude to the world. In this regard, it is very important to distinguish, on the one hand, the characteristics of the child's drawing that reflect the child's level of mental development and mastery of drawing techniques, and the characteristics of the picture that reflect personal characteristics.
